It is an initiative taken by the Department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances, and Pension to provide a-RTI portal Gateway to the citizens for quick search of information on the details of first Appellate Authorities. Besides access to RTI related information/ disclosures published on the website by various Public Authorities under India and the State Governments.

Objectives of the Right to Information Act:

The primary object of the right to information act is to empower the citizens, promote transparency and accountability in the working of the government, contain corruption, and make our democracy work for the people in an absolute sense. The act is a big step towards making the citizens informed about the activities of the government. An informed citizen is better equipped to keep necessary vigil on the governance instruments and make the government more accountable to the governed.

About Sitarang Charitable Society:

Shri Sitaram Ranguji Shinde founded the Trust in July 1997. He is a farmer and took education up to VIth standard. The Trust successfully runs one English Medium Primary School up to Vth standard, one Marathi Medium secondary school up to Xth standard, one Junior College with Arts, Commerce, and science streams, affiliated to the Maharashtra State Secondary and Higher Secondary Board, Pune, and one senior college with Arts, Commerce, and science streams affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University. Recently 800 students are completing their education in the branches run by the Trust.

At the initial period, the Trust had taken initiatives for enhancing rural youth educational competency through the public reading library activity. The president of the Trust had got a good response from the villagers and youth, through with he started primary schools, junior, and senior college in the vicinity and provided educational need of the area.

In the vicinity of the college, none of the education facility was existed, and the female students were not taken education nor continued their education up to degree level. The Trust started senior college affiliated with the state public university from 24th July 2006 with Arts, commerce, and science streams with fewer students and solved the educational problem of the vicinity.
